8. Millepora gonagra, Milne-Edwards and Haime.

Millepora gonagra, Milne-Edwards and Haime, Cor., iii. p. 230, pl. F 3, fig. 1.

Three specimens occur in the collection. The comosteum in the very young stages takes on the peculiar, small-lobed form of the large specimens, and differs in this respect from the long-ridged forms of the young specimens of *Millepora verrucosa*; nevertheless the two species are very closely allied. The pores are scattered irregularly; but often the dactylopores are gathered in large numbers around the gastropores.

Localities.—Samboangan, Philippines; Kandavu; Tahiti.
