- Fig. 1. A specimen, preserved in alcohol, somewhat damaged at the basal part of the stalk; natural size.
- Fig. 2. Transverse section of the wall, near the superior sharp margin (combination figure);  $\times 10$ .
- Fig. 3. Part of a parenchymal diact, with club-shaped echinated ends;  $\times 300$ .
- Fig. 4. Bow-shaped, slightly bent, strong parenchymal diact;  $\times 100$ .
- Fig. 5. Oxyhexaster with long, slightly bent, terminal rays;  $\times 450$ .
- Fig. 6. Small oxyhexaster with very short principal and numerous terminal rays, the latter varying in length;  $\times 450$ .
